



# 2021 Annual Report






- ASERL has established national leadership in Professional Development for research libraries, with an emphasis on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) topics
- In 2020-21, the number of webinars offered by ASERL nearly doubled from previous year
- More than 34,000 people registered, attended, or viewed our webinars, from around the globe
- DEI-related sessions attract the largest audiences

#### Careful Stewardship of Print Collections



- Of ASERL's 37 member libraries, 33 are retaining legacy print journals for the long term, ensuring preservation and access of the scholarly record
- Journal retention commitments among ASERL libraries has quadrupled over the past four years
- Together, ASERL, WRLC and FLARE comprise the Scholars Trust alliance
- Scholars Trust is a founding partner in the Rosemont Shared Print Alliance, a federation of leading Shared Print programs in North America


#### **Exploring New Ways to Share Resources**
